The Tribe 2013 Proprietary Red (Sonoma County)

92 POINTS

Co-fermented Syrah, Petite Sirah and Zinfandel from the Mounts Vineyard in Dry Creek Valley were all picked the same day for this blend that's tight, sinewy and smoky in sanguine notes of baked plum, cranberry and baked bread. It comes together in a softly layered package, drinking well now. Kosher. —V.B.

The Tribe 2014 Chardonnay (Lodi)

90 POINTS

Luscious melon aromas, creamy fruit-tart flavors and a silky texture make a pleasing combination in this wonderfully soothing wine. A crisp core of lemon and apple flavors are surrounded by a layer of vanilla and hazelnut. The plush texture carries the flavors through a long finish. Kosher. —J.G.
